Devon to wit The Examination of Mary Burnett now residing in the Parish of Littleham & Exmouth in the said County taken on Oath before us Two of his Majesty's Justices of the Peace in and for the said County this 15<sup>th</sup> Day of September 1801 touching her legal place of Settlement

Who saith that about twenty five years since she was Married to Samuel Burnett at Mary Steps in the County & City of Exeter, that this deponant does not know the settlement of the said Samuel Burnett, that this Examination believes the settlement of his Parents was in Woodbury in the said County, that this Examinant was born in the Parish of Bratton Clovelly in the said County as she has heard and believes which was the settlement of her Parents, that she continued to live with her parents untill she was about fifteen years of Age and then hired with her Uncle in the said Parish of Bratton Clovelly for some years, that this Examinant never hired One Year in Service at one place nor done any other Act or deed whereby to gain a Settlement but as above to the best of her knowledge and belief [the mark of Mary Burnett]
